We are continuing to offer fun and different types of activities as the snow melts and warmer temperatures increase. During the month of April, we celebrate Easter. Easter is the Christian holiday celebrating the Resurrection, or bringing back to life, of Jesus Christ three days after his crucifixion. In Christian tradition, the Resurrection represents Christ's victory over death and the promise of eternal life for those who follow him. Some Christians refer to Easter as Resurrection Day or Resurrection Sunday. Easter Sunday marks the end of the 46-day preparatory season of Lent, which is significant in cultures around the world.

Covid-19 Updates

We are not in outbreak status (zero positive staff or residents) which means residents do not need to be tested. CMS visitation guidelines from 11/12/2021 outlining indoor visitation, visitor testing/vaccination, and resident outings are still in effect. If you have any questions, please continue to reach out!!

SMP Health – Maryhill has an active policy in place to be compliant with the federal mandate at this time and all staff working within the building are either vaccinated or have an approved exemption. Everyone with an approved exemption does need to follow additional guidelines for everyone's protection.

Once the official guidance comes out about offering an additional COVID-19 booster, we will have the ability to offer an additional dose at Maryhill to all residents. We will keep everyone informed but it looks like an official recommendation will be advised in April.
