If someone wants to follow you out or asks you to open the door, please grab a staff member to ensure it is safe before proceeding. We want to make it as easy as possible for visitors to exit and we appreciate your assistance in helping us keep the residents as safe as possible. When in doubt, always ask. Also please continue to screen in to obtain a visitor badge. Please wear the badge while you are inside the building.

At the end of July, we got a new roof due to storm damage that occurred. Sorry for any inconvenience during the project but thank you for your patience so we can continue to keep the building in good working condition.

The Cordless phone is back in working condition, we got a replacement. If you ever want to talk to your loved one who does not have a cell phone, we are able to transfer any calls that come to the facility to the cordless. Thank you for your patience while that option was out of service.

The community channel with MLGC is now up and running. The content is on channel 90. We have a TV in the main hallway that showcases all the different information for the day including meals and activities. This will be for internal viewing only, but residents can reference it at any time within their rooms via the MLGC set top box.
