Christmas Decorating:

Use only UL-listed holiday lights and wiring. Avoid visually blocking egresses, exit signage, or any fire safety equipment (pull stations, fire extinguishers, and sprinkler heads). Avoid hanging decorations from sprinkler heads. Inspect holiday lighting for frayed or exposed wires.
