Building Updates: We're excited to share that the new courtyard expansion fence has been installed (pictures below)! This project has created additional outdoor space for our residents, families, and visitors to enjoy, providing an even more welcoming environment for relaxation, activities, and time spent together. The next phase of the project is implementing access control. Once this system is fully installed, tested, and operational, residents and visitors will be able to access the courtyard through the west exit doors as well, making the space more convenient and accessible.



Tobacco/Smoke Free Facility:

Maryhill prohibits the possession of tobacco and THC products within the building and bans its use on facility premises. These products include but are not limited to: cigarettes, pipes, cigars, e-cigarettes, vapes, chewing tobacco, marijuana, THC edibles and gummies. This applies to all residents and visitors. SMP Health - Maryhill is a "Tobacco/Smoke Free Facility." "No Smoking" signs and signs that identify this facility as a "Smoke Free Facility" will be prominently displayed at entrances. Smoking materials (lighters), tobacco products (including cigarettes, pipes, cigars, e-cigarettes, or smokeless/chewing tobacco), and products containing THC are discouraged from being inside the building but would be locked up if someone has them in their possession. These products are not allowed in resident rooms. Just a friendly reminder that staff members are not permitted to purchase or provide personal tobacco products to residents. Visitors are not allowed to purchase tobacco products for other residents within the facility and if you are buying for your loved ones these need to be locked up in the nurse's station as they are not allowed in rooms. Staff members are not permitted to take residents outside to smoke at any time and if you allow your loved one to smoke while out on an outing off facilities grounds that is entirely up to you. Thank you for your corporation and understanding to keep Maryhill a smoke-free facility.
