Legislative Update – Sandy Teubner

As you know there were several bills in the legislature, St. Aloisius was following this past year. Medicaid Expansion HB 1012 was one of them. As part of the Affordable Care Act, Medicaid Expansion was funded a few years ago which gave people health insurance when they were under the age of 65 with incomes below 138% of the federal poverty level. This was particularly beneficial for childless adults and working individuals who made too much money to qualify for traditional Medicaid but not enough to gualify for health exchanges. In ND it covered 20,000 individuals who did not have health insurance previously. It was scheduled to sunset in July of 2017, but was approved for the next 2 years. In 2017 it is funded 95% by federal dollars and 5% by the state. In future years the state's share will increase up to 7% then 10%. It has an economic impact on ND Hospitals of \$190 million dollars per year. It has had a benefit to St. Aloisius of \$378,000 in cash payments last year, and \$160,000 this year through May. These are significant dollars that would have gone to collections/bad debt. Calling directly to the department you need would help you get to who you need much quicker and would free up the main phone line significantly.


REMEMBER
