The results from our COVID testing on Monday 10/12/2020 remains 100% negative with all of our residents. We did have 2 employees who test came back positive and both of them have been sent home and are isolating through the 14 day period. Contact tracing has been completed and there has NOT been a high exposure to any residents. This means that we have no residents under isolation at this time.

We have made it a mandatory requirement that all staff and visitors are screened upon entering Sheyenne Care Center. It is also mandatory for all staff to wear a mask and goggles at all time. Along with continually communicating to staff to social distance in and outside of work and hand sanitizing is so important in the prevention of COVID.

Due to the screening of employees, mandatory Personal Protective Equipment staff has to wear and the weekly testing of residents and staff we have been able to isolate the spread of this virus. This is why Sheyenne Care Center has not had any transmission of the COVID virus within our buildings.

Our next testing is Tuesday the 20th of October from 6am to 4pm.
