Our current indoor visitation is from 2:00 pm to 6:45 pm 7 days a week in the library. One hour of visitation per family member per day and no one under 18 can schedule a meeting. Also remember that you and your family member need to be wearing a mask at all time and sanitizes your hands before, during and after your visit. I can't stress how important it is to schedule 24 hours in advance and to be considerate about other families wanting to visit their loved one. With the limited time frames we have available at this time, please do not schedule back to back days of visitations.
