Sheyenne Care Center COVID test occurred on Monday (1/18/2021). The test result from on Monday COVID test identified 100% negative both residents and staff results.

We have reopened for visitation under limited restriction starting today 1/18/21. I have attached the policy on family visitation to our Sheyenne Care Center Facebook and on our Webpage. You can start to schedule your visitation with the social service department. Please remember that if we have a positive COVID test turn up at Sheyenne Care Center we will according to CMS guideline have to restrict visitations.

If positive test results occur, residents will be moved into isolation immediately. The nurse will notify the family member immediately of the positive test result, and the resident will be moved onto the isolation area, located on the 4th floor. Employees testing positive employees are sent home in isolation until cleared to return to work.

We continue to offer residents and workers the COVID vaccine. If you would like your loved one to receive the vaccine, please contact our Social Service representative and visit them on the procedure we need to follow. We do need consent from either the resident or their guardian before a vaccine is provided.

Our next COVID testing period is Thursday, January 21st. Please continue to be safe, socially distant, wear a mask, and wash hands, frequently sanitize, and social distance to protect yourself and others from this virus.
